Pastor's Notes

Demetrius has a *good* testimony from all, and from the truth itself. And we also bear witness, and you know that our testimony is true. (3 John 1:12)

"Demetrius has a good testimony from all" is a way of saying let me introduce you to one that is doing the things that God has called him to do. "And from the truth itself" tells us that "Demetrius" doctrine proves that he is a true "God Fearing Preacher"! (2 Tim. 4:1-2, I charge you therefore before God and the Lord Jesus Christ, who will judge the living and the dead at His appearing and His kingdom: Preach the word! Be ready in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all long-suffering and teaching.) A mans "Doctrine" will tell you if he has a real respect for the "Word of God" or not, and "Demetrius" certainly did! Another way of knowing that "Demetrius" was a "True Servant" is "And we also bear witness" which meant that the "Apostle John" was putting his own stamp of approval on "Demetrius"! We need to be those who have a real respect for the Word of God and "Be diligent to present yourself approved to God (2 Tim. 2:15)" like "Demetrius" so that we may have a "good" and "true" testimony.




