"Now by this we know that we love Him, if we keep His commandments." (1 John 2:3)

The Holy Spirit, speaking through the apostle John, says that we will be sure that we know God by the way we live, not by what we say. John is once again bringing in the walking test, not the talking test, to see if we are truly "born again". If you love Me, keep my commandments. (1 John 14:15) We really need to give attention to the word "know" in this verse. It means to have an intimate, experiential, relationship with God. It means to really understand His heart, and to agree with His heart in all our ways. The word for "know" in the greek is ginosko, and it means to be aware of, to feel what He feels, and to have the same knowledge, understanding, and desires. We also need to notice the word "keep" in this verse. The word "keep" in the greek is tern which means to guard carefully like a precious treasure by keeping our eye on it. Let us be those who have an intimate relationship with the Lord and be those who keep his commandments. The Lord is not saying that we will have perfect obedience to His commandments, but our goal should always be "Holiness" My Sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow me.
