I've stayed in contact with my new born baby and restored my relationship with my girlfriend, and am on the path to being reunited with her. I have truly surrendered all to the Lord. I have a joy in my life that drugs could never give me. I continue to learn more and strengthen my walk with the Lord. I finally have hope for the future.
