His sister had custody of our children and she told me that I needed to take care of myself for my children's sake, as he was still very abusive. June 15, 2022 was the day I came to U-Turn for Christ and fully surrendered everything to God. It was the day I was done running. I had been living in sin thinking that I would be able to stop, when God gave me the strength to leave. I found U-Turn for Christ when I had walked into a church and a Pastor Tommy Cota had called U-Turn for Christ on my behalf. After that he put me in a cab which sent me straight here. Since coming here to U-Turn for Christ I have been reunited with my kids and they have forgiven me. Other members of my family have forgiven me too. Currently I'm in the second phase and working at the Thrift Store. Today, God is working

on something new in me which He is not yet finished.


