Now when the apostles who were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of

God, the sent Peter and John to them, who, when they had come down, prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit. For as yet He has fallen upon none of them. They had only baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. Then they laid hands on them, and received the Holy Spirit. (Acts 8:14-17)

Here again we see the (3) part work of the Holy Spirit

- #1) Para = The Holy Spirit guiding them to Jesus.
- #2) Para = The Holy Spirit being in by accepting Jesus.
- #3) Para = The Holy Spirit coming upon.

I believe that the reason for this laying on of hands was so that "Unity" would be seen as Peter and John received them into the family of God as they baptized not only in water but by "God the Holy Spirit" also. Remember with me that the Apostles had a really bad taste in their mouth for the "Samaritans" from when they were with Jesus and treated the way they were.

This is part of the reason that I believe there was huge importance to Peter and John coming to Samaria to welcome the believers into the church family!

For there is no partiality with God. (Romans 2:11)

It is important to know that all of God's children are able to receive the filling of the **Holy Spirit**, no matter if we are fully Jew, half Jew and Gentile, or fully Gentile like us.

Church please listen, God wants you to receive the **Baptism of the Holy Spirit** and become a bold witness for Him as well.
