"Then, having fasted and prayed, and laid hands on them, they sent them away." Acts 13:3 PASTOR'S NOTES

In the previous verses we see that the Holy Spirit had just called Barnabas and Saul to the work of the ministry. What I really would like to focus on is the importance of fasting, praying, and the laying on of hands. Fasting is simply putting off the feeding of the flesh, or if you will, a moving away from the world so as to place ourselves in the presence of and to be more sensitive to the Holy Spirit in our lives. As for praying, two things are happening here, a lifting up of the men in intercessory words to the Lord, and an asking of protection and provision over them. And lastly, laying on of hands, a sign of being in agreement with or in support of the men, or women, and the ministry that the Lord has called him or her to do. Let us be those who take time to do just that for our leaders in the church. Whether it is a new Pastor being ordained, or a group of missionaries being sent out to do His work, let us remember this example in Acts 13 and be those who fast, pray, and lay hands on those who are sent.
