


PASTOR'S NOTES

After researching online where I could go to a rehab that didn't include taking medication, the Lord led me to U-Turn For Christ in November 2005, and I

committed to first phase. That was the first in a long time I hadn't been depressed on my birthday, Thanksgiving, Christmas, or New Year! I walked with Jesus at the Ranch and learned to have a relationship with Him through reading His Word and Prayer, and also that fellowship and accountability with like-minded Christians were just as important in my Christian walk. I met Alex while we were serving at an outreach in Mexico in February 2006. I also gained a new family at Calvary Chapel Romoland. I found confidence in the Lord and know that God was preparing me to be who I am today - a Pastor's wife with a husband who has such a servant's heart, and a mother of 3 children who love the Lord!
