"Now it was not written for his sake alone that it was imputed to him, but also for us. It shall be imputed to us

who believe in Him who raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead, who was delivered up because of our offenses, and was raised because of our justification." (Romans 4:23-25)

Jesus rising from the grave and sitting at the right hand of the Father making intercession for us is proof that He fulfilled all the requirements of God in dealing with the payment of our sins, having completed it. Romans 6:23 says, "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." 2 Corinthians 5:2 says "For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him." I now surrender to Him daily

and allow the Holy Spirit to guide every decision I make. The Lord has surrounded my family and me with other godly families at church. I thank God for my brothers and sisters in Christ and the ministry at U-Turn For Christ.
