PASTOR'S NOTES

"Now it happened, as I journeyed and came near Damascus at about noon, suddenly a great light from heaven shone around me. And I fell to the

ground and heard a voice saying to me, 'Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me?' So I answered, 'Who are You, Lord?' And He said to me, 'I am Jesus of Nazareth, whom you are persecuting.' And those who were with me indeed saw the light and were afraid, but they did not hear the voice of Him who spoke to me." (Acts 22:6-9)

Saul was so far away from being a "Believer" that a "Radical Encounter" had to take place and it did, as this is one of the greatest conversions to ever take place...or is it? I think my conversion was one of the greatest conversions, and I hope you all think the same of yours. I was so far away from knowing "Jesus as Lord" that it really took a "Radical Encounter" to change my life as well! Notice that the sin Saul was involved in was against "Jesus" Himself- "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me?" We need to realize that all sin is against the Lord! You remember when Potiphar's wife was after Joseph to lie with her, and Joseph's response was, "There is no one greater in the house than I, nor has he kept back anything from me but you, because you are his wife. How then can I do this great wickedness, and sin against God?" (Genesis 39:9) The Lord makes it very clear that though Paul's hatred was against "Christians" his sin was against the Lord! We need to remember that every kind of sin is against the Lord.

"So I said, 'What shall I do, Lord?' And the Lord said to me, 'Arise and go into Damascus, and there you will be told all things which are appointed for you to do.' And since I could not see for the glory of that light, being led by the hand of those who were with me, I came into Damascus.'" (Acts 22:10-11)



Notice the "Fruit of Repentance" shown right away in this radical supernatural encounter with Jesus that took place in Paul's life. This is the response that all of us should have daily with the Lord. We should be asking ourselves, "what can I do for the Lord?", because true Lordship is submitting to whatever He wants. Let us be obedient to the Lord and be about His business!
