

PASTOR'S NOTES

"...but declared first to those in Damascus and in Jerusalem, and throughout all the region of Judea, and then to the Gentiles, that they should repent, turn to God, and do works befitting repentance." (Acts 26:20)

Notice Paul's stand here in light of who he is talking to. This man seemingly had the power to take Paul's life, but Paul speaks out the gospel message to him. If you are going to be a man or woman of God, then you have to be willing to step out and share the truth of God's Word.

I know there are a lot of churches that are excited about the ecumenical movement going on in the church today, but I'm not real excited because I see it as a lot of compromise. Paul would not compromise, he called for people to "repent of their sins" just as Jesus taught, and we at U-Turn For Christ are given to the same standard.

I'm not going to tell you that it's alright for you to stay in that immoral relationship, or that it's okay to use drugs as long as you don't use anything harder than pot. Nor am I going to tell you it's fine to hold a grudge against a person who has sinned against you. What I will tell you is that you need to "*repent*" and get right with God and with man. We need to take Paul's example and be those that are bold to share the truth of God's Word. And not just Paul, look at what Jesus said in Luke 13:3, "I tell you, no; but unless you repent you will all likewise perish." I pray we would take these examples from the Word and apply them in our lives.
