***"And when Saul had come to Jerusalem, he tried to join the disciples; but they were all afraid of him, and did not believe that he was a disciple." - Acts 9:26***

After the killing of Stephen, Acts 7:58 tells us, ***"And they cast him out of the city and stoned him. And the witnesses laid down their clothes at the feet of a young man named Saul."***
