PASTOR'S NOTES

"It came to pass in those days that Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee, and was bap-

tized by John in the Jordan. And immediately, coming up from the water, He saw the heavens parting and the Spirit descending upon Him like a dove. Then a voice came from heaven, 'You are My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.'" – Mark 1:9-11

As we now journey into the gospel of Mark, we see Jesus being baptized. There are a few times in scripture where we see the Trinity before us in plain view, and the baptism of Jesus is one of those instances.

As Jesus is being baptized, the Holy Spirit appears in the form of a dove, and God the Father declares His pleasure in His Son. This moment serves as the perfect example for us to follow in making a public declaration of our faith through baptism. It's also a perfect example of what happens when we pray.

Notice what happens as Jesus is baptized and starts to pray. Luke 3:21-22 describes it more, "When all the people were baptized, it came to pass that Jesus also was baptized; and while He prayed, the heaven was opened. And the Holy Spirit descended in bodily form like a dove upon Him, and a voice came from heaven which said, 'You are My beloved Son; in You I am well pleased.'"

I believe that if we want heaven to be opened to us, if we want to be filled with God the Holy Spirit, and if we want to hear God the Father say that He is well pleased with us, we ought to spend more time just like Jesus did—praying.
